Each Homeshare match has the back up of their local Homeshare organisation, which selects and approves them and individually matches their interests, lifestyle and hobbies. Security and household checks are completed and ongoing support provided to both people in the match.


Homesharing is not a rental service so a Homesharer doesn't pay rent. Instead household bills are split fairly. The Homesharer and Householder will both pay a fee to their local Homeshare organisation to cover the costs of their service and support.

Every Homeshare organisation is a member of Homeshare UK, the UK network for Homeshare, supported by Shared Lives Plus, the UK network for shared living.

Why choose Homeshare?

- It helps you stay independently at home for longer (Householders)
- It provides affordable accommodation at a time of record housing shortages and high rent (Homesharers)
- It gives you and your loved ones peace of mind
